HAZARD COMMUNICATION TRAINING

Training Overview

Advanced EHS Concepts Limited Hazard Communication (HAZCOM) training course is fully customisable and helps organisations to meet their responsibilities as depicted in the Occupational Safety and Health Act 2004 (as amended 2006) and internationally recognized regulation e.g. Code of Federal Regulations 29 CFR 1910.1200.

This course fulfils basic requirements for employees who may be exposed to hazardous chemicals and specifically trains employees to know that they are exposed to hazardous chemicals.

Participants will use actual MSDS sheets to determine safety information on simulated chemical container prior to handling the product.

Who should attend?

This course is designed as an awareness level course, for every worker who is, or is likely to be exposed to hazardous chemicals in the workplace.
